An Overview:

The Language Laboratory is established in accordance with AICTE norms to strengthen students' communication competencies and employability skills through technology-enabled learning. The laboratory focuses on the systematic development of LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing) skills, with special emphasis on listening and speaking abilities during the First and Second Semesters, thereby addressing foundational communication requirements. Whereas in third and fourth semesters Reading and writing skills are emphasised.

Equipped with LAN connectivity and reliable internet access, the Language Lab enables students to utilize a wide range of digital, audio-visual, and interactive language learning resources. The use of authentic audio and video materials simulating real-life and professional situations enhances practical communication skills, critical thinking, and contextual language use.

The Language Lab supports **Outcome-Based Education (OBE)** by facilitating self-paced learning, continuous practice, and immediate feedback, allowing students to monitor their own progress and achieve defined course outcomes. The laboratory also promotes learner autonomy, confidence building, and effective interpersonal communication.

Experienced and trained faculty members oversee laboratory sessions, guide students in skill enhancement activities. Regular monitoring ensures optimal utilization of ICT resources.
