


Investiture Ceremony and Fresher’s Day

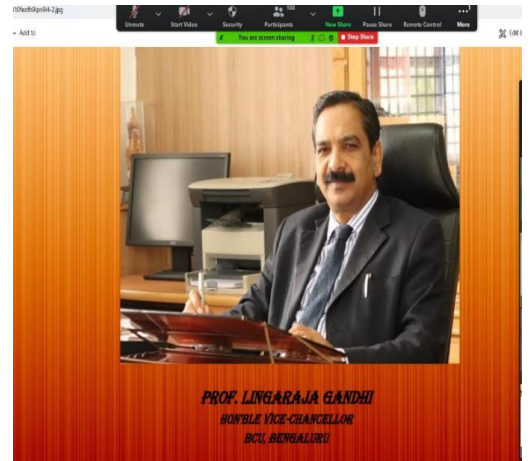

It is a highly versatile language having the power of expressing all types of thoughts in appropriate terminology. Sanskrit is indeed a very rich language which deserves highest position in the hierarchy of languages. Primacy of recognition should be given to Sanskrit which is a treasure of knowledge. 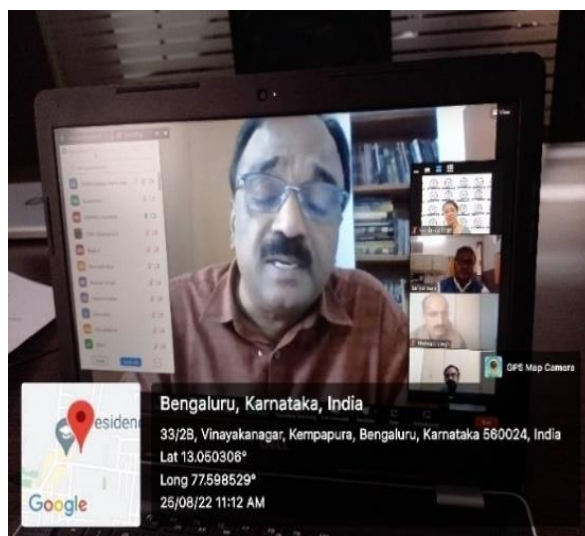
Bangalore. Twelve research papers were presented and the deliberations were interesting and thought provoking.

Basaveswara College, Bangalore, was the Chairperson for Sanskrit technical session. Twenty three research papers were presented by the researchers on various topics based on the theme of the conference and deliberations gave way for new outlook and at the same time were highly beneficial for the participants and presenters.

Dr. B S Srikanta in his presidential remarks remarked that Most people or most of us experience anxiety, depression and stress at some point of time in our lives. But for many, these are short term emotions and do not affect their quality of life too much. But for some people, these negative emotions can result in deep depression causing them to question their existence in life. This is known as Existential Crisis. This aspect has been studied well by psychologists as early as 1929. He also enumerated causes for existential crisis. He said that Literature plays a very important role in overcoming stress, depression, heart break and even negativity. During First World War, in Britain hospitals, doctors and nurses recommended patients who complained of trauma disorder to read literature. It was found effective in comforting many patients. Host of books were made available to the patients. He pointed out that Yoga, meditation, spiritual activities, ability to take successes and failures with the same stride, positive thinking, avoiding impulsive reactions and developing habit of reading good literature are known to reduce the problem of Existential Crisis.

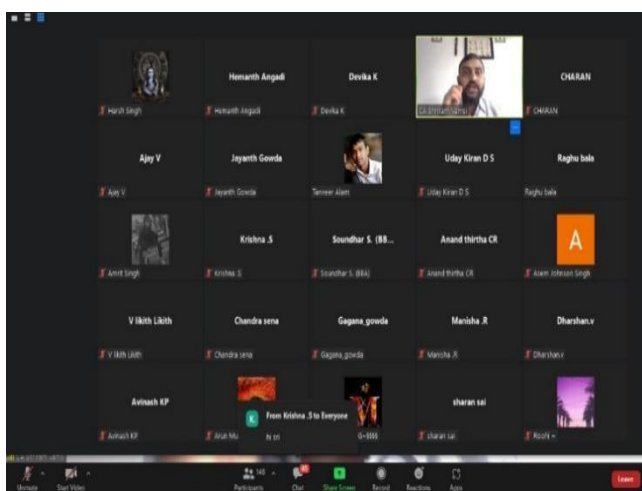

& Average case of algorithms, the Graphical Representation and Benefits of Asymptotic Analysis etc.

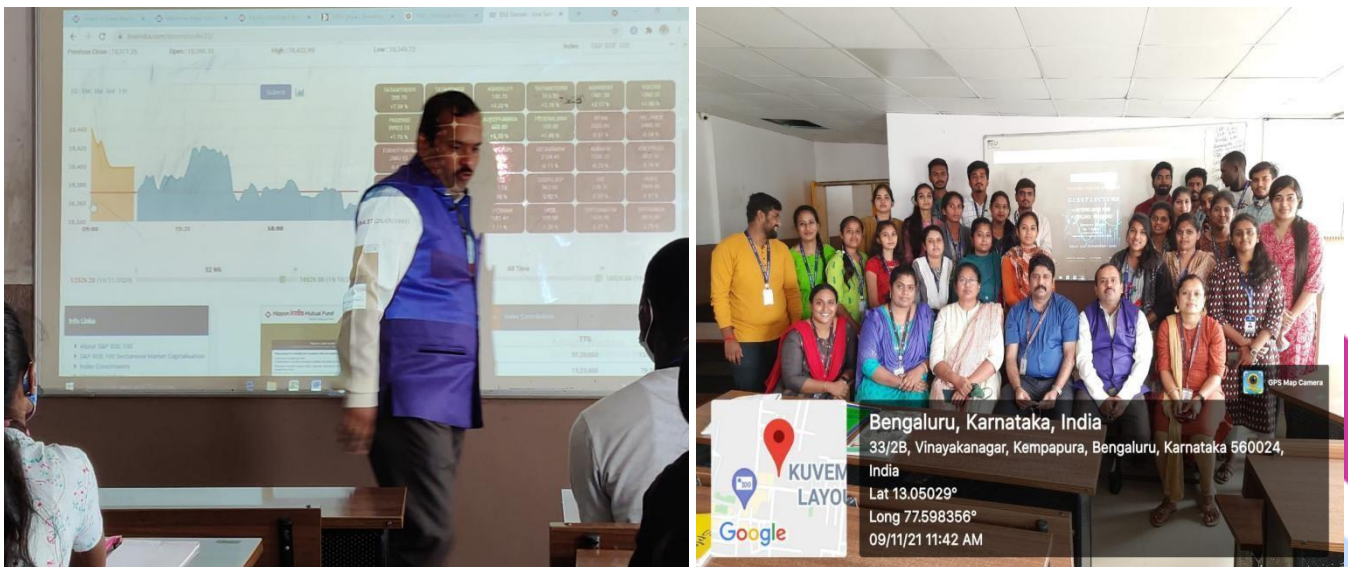
Guest Lecture on “Career Guidance”

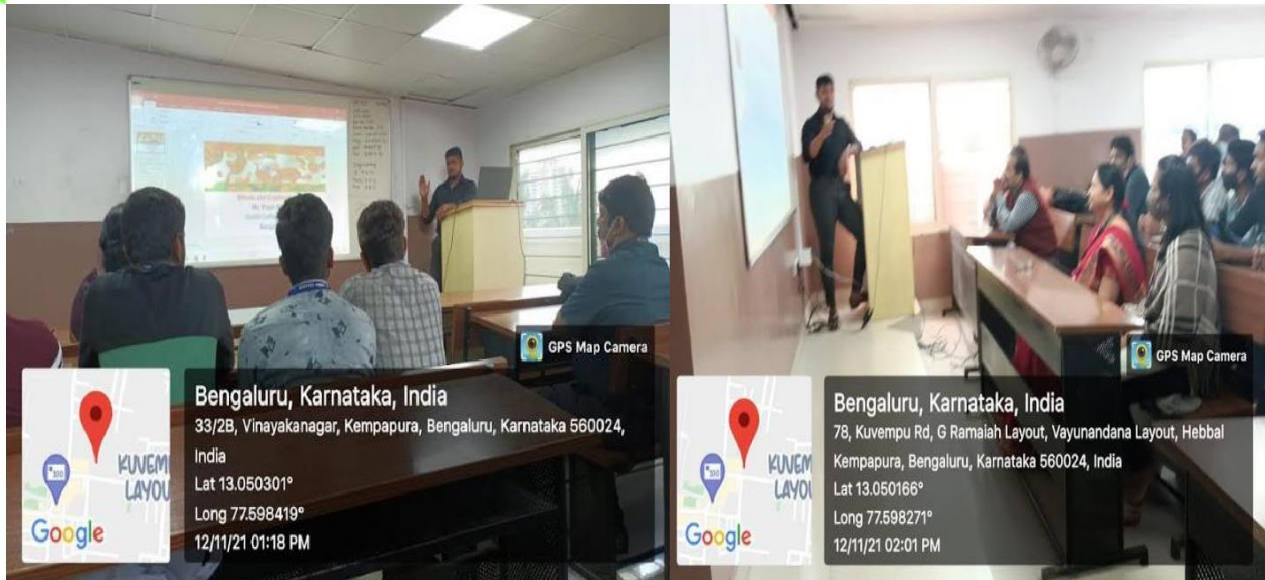
Guest Lecture on “Guidelines for Online Trading”

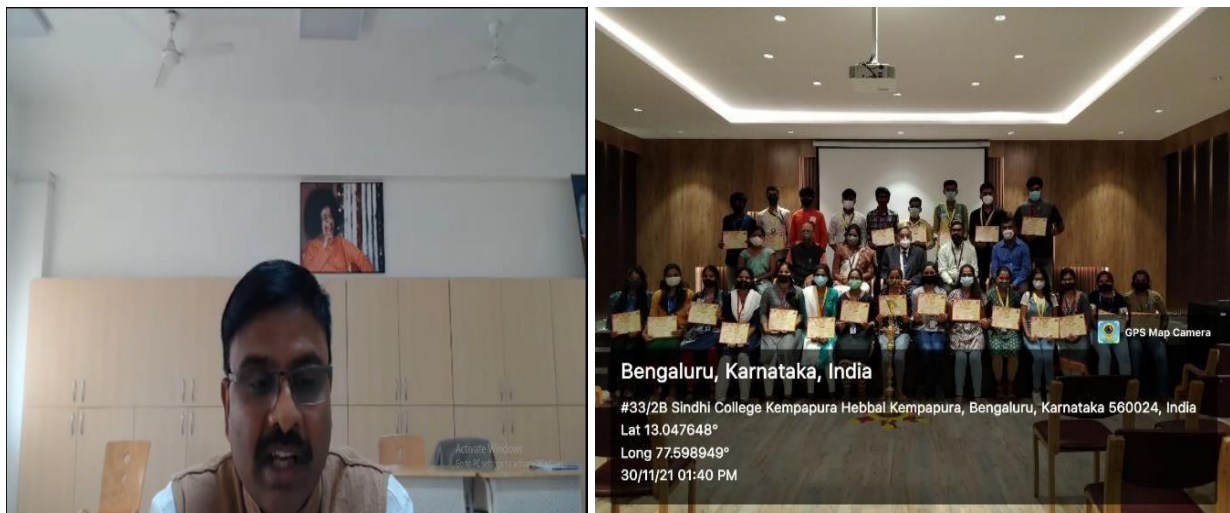
Symposium on “Bitcoins & Crypto Currency”

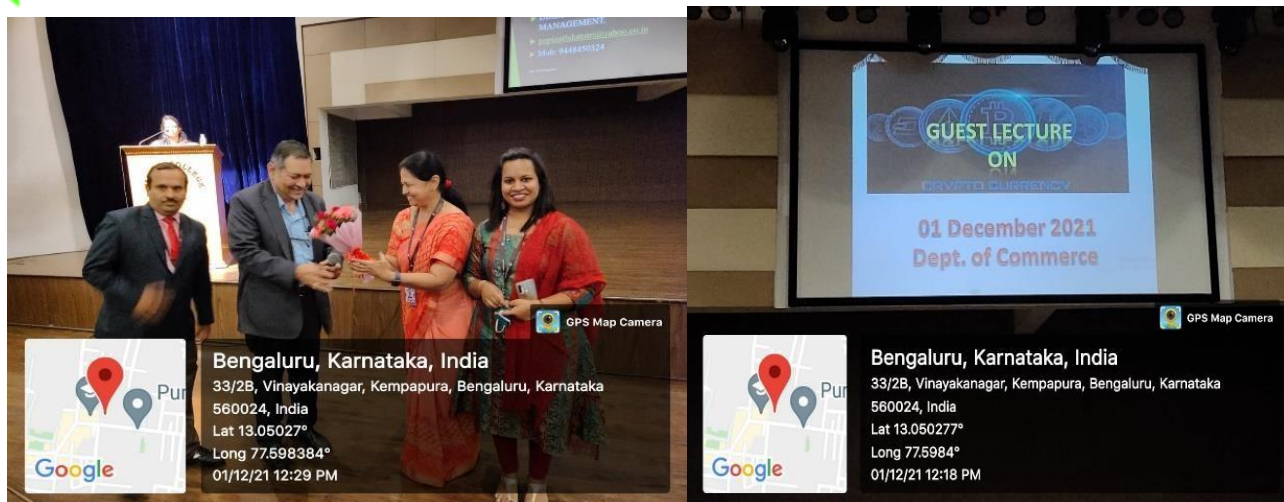
Guest Lecture on “Nadu Nudi Sambhrama”

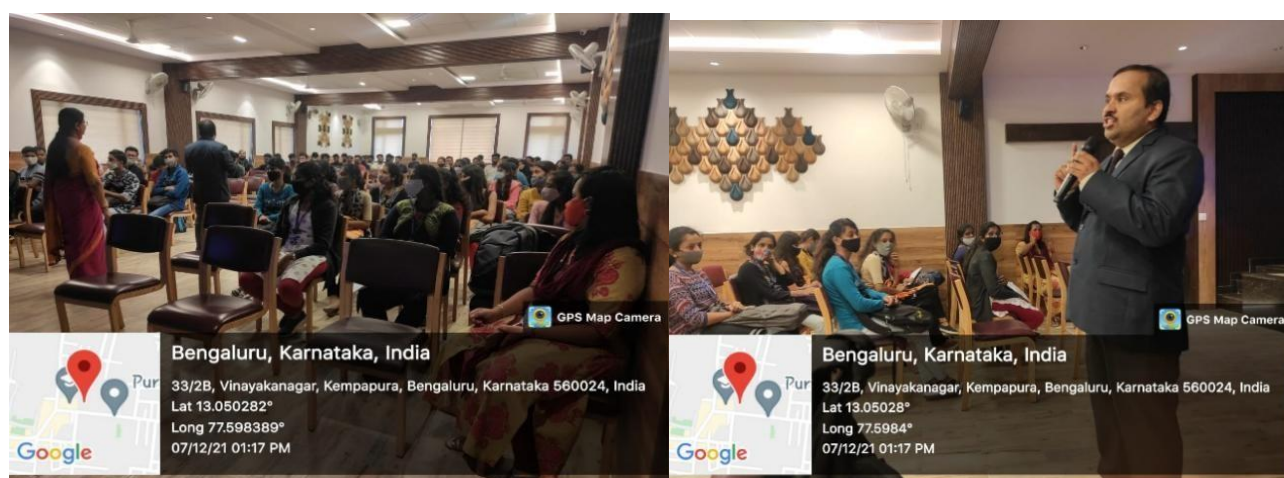
Guest Lecture on “Cryptocurrency”

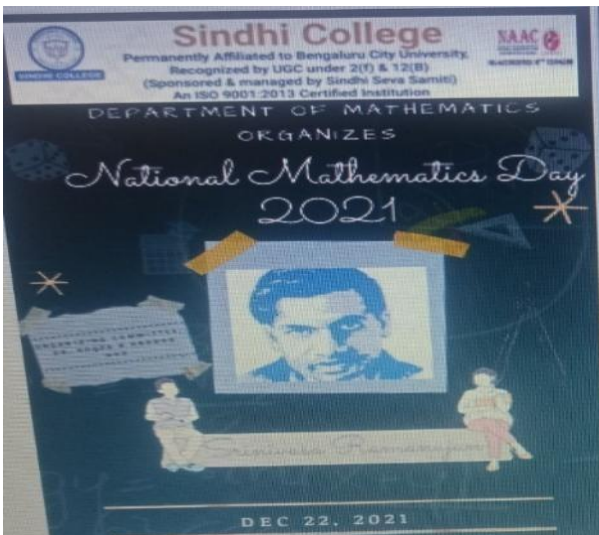
Guest Lecture on “Career Guidance”

Guest Lecture on “National Mathematics Day”

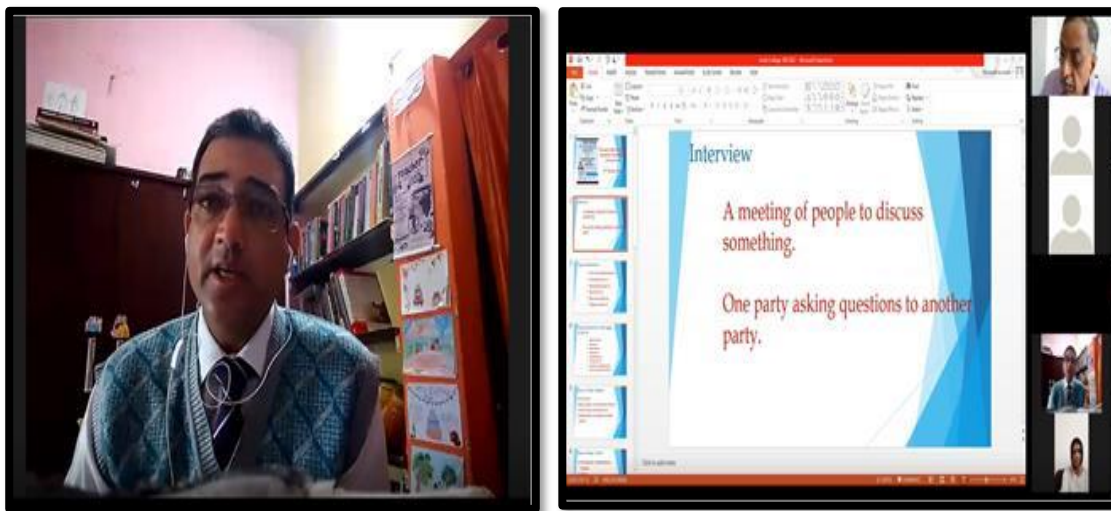

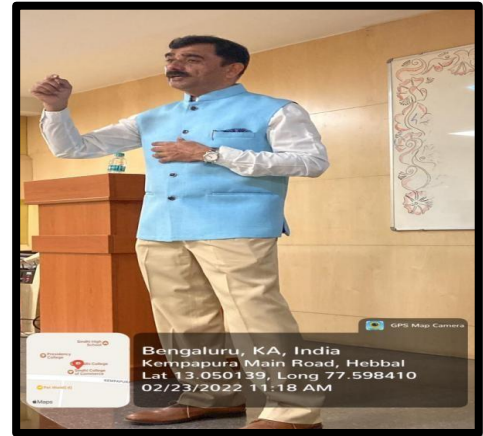

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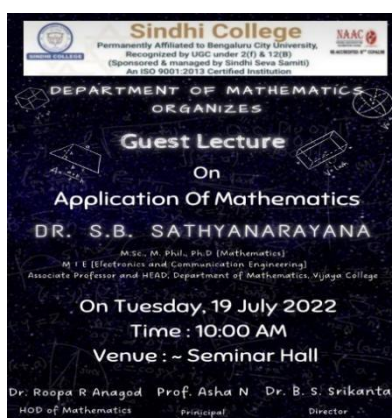


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Guest Lecture on “Application of Mathematics”

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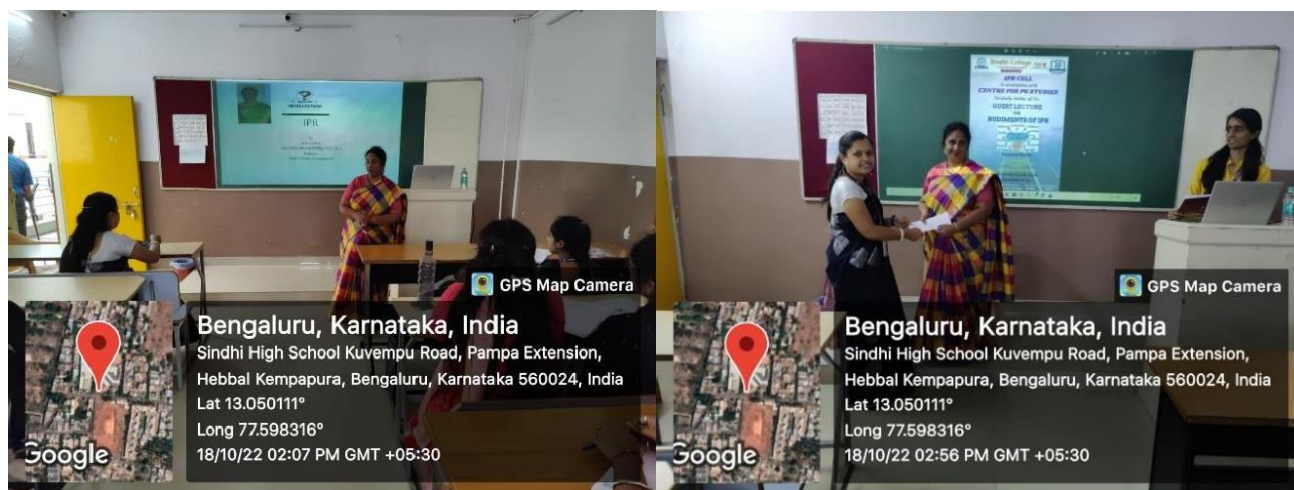


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Guest Lecture on “Rudiments of IPR”

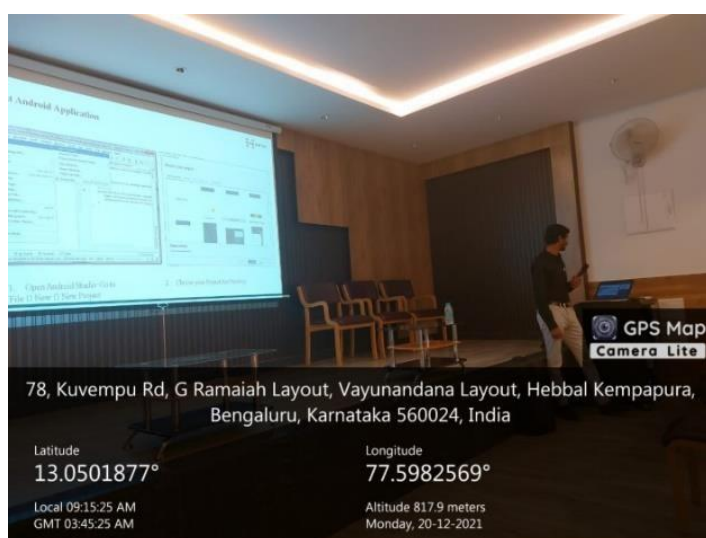

Workshop on “Introduction to SPSS”

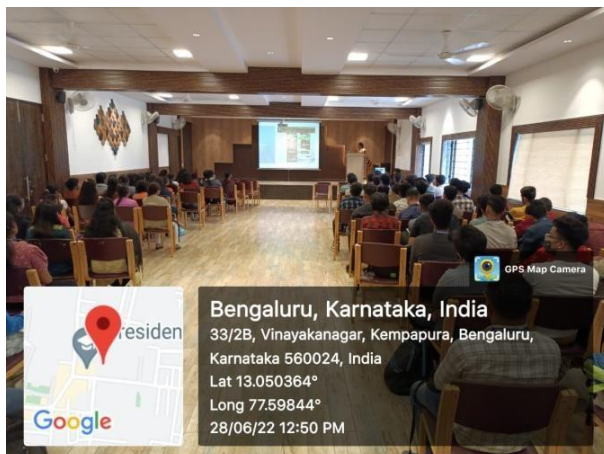

UGC NET/SET COACHING CLASSES

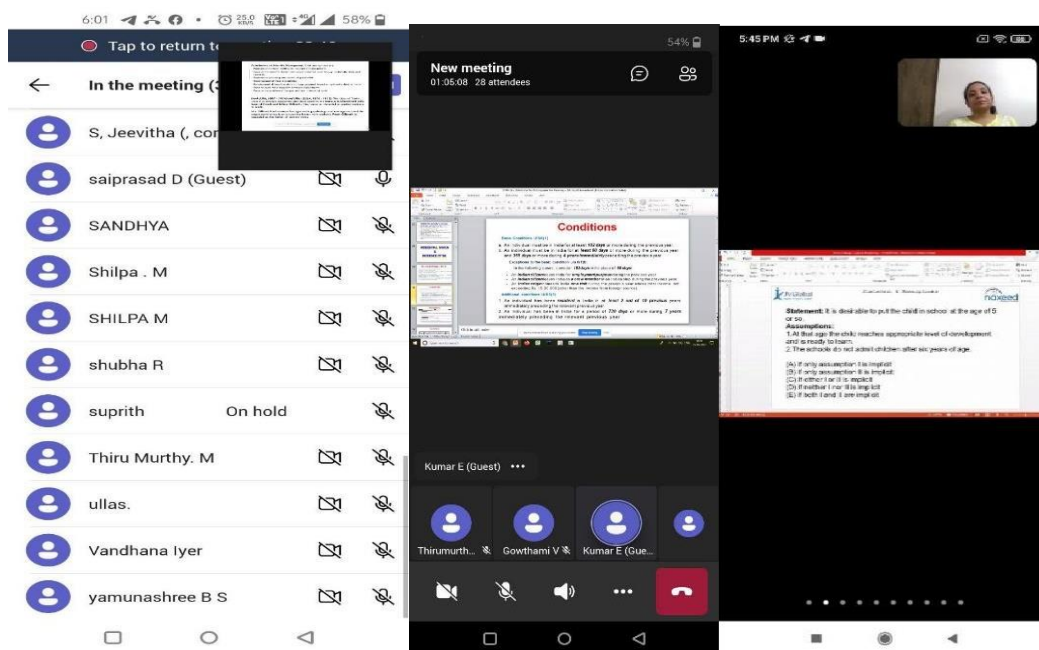

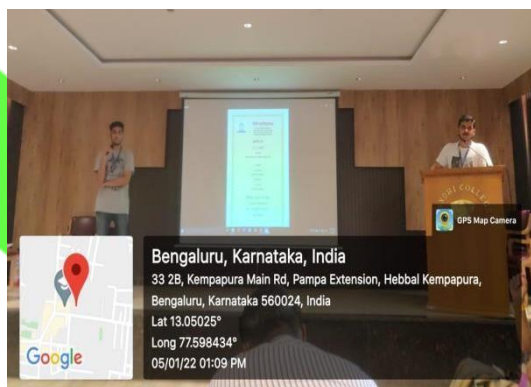
The key factors addressed were related to gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow and understanding the significance of girls’ education. 47 members were a part of this grand event.

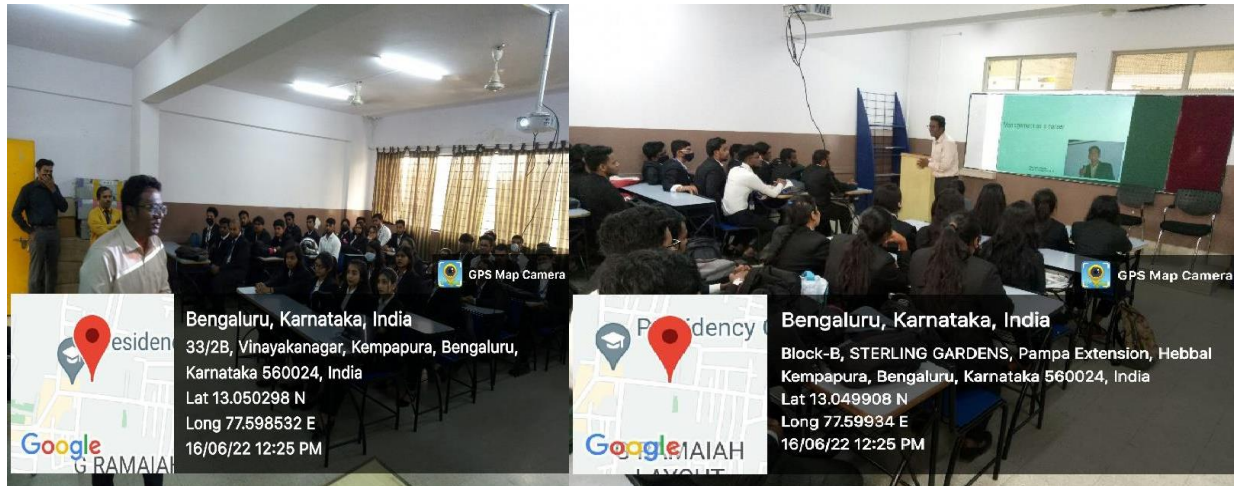

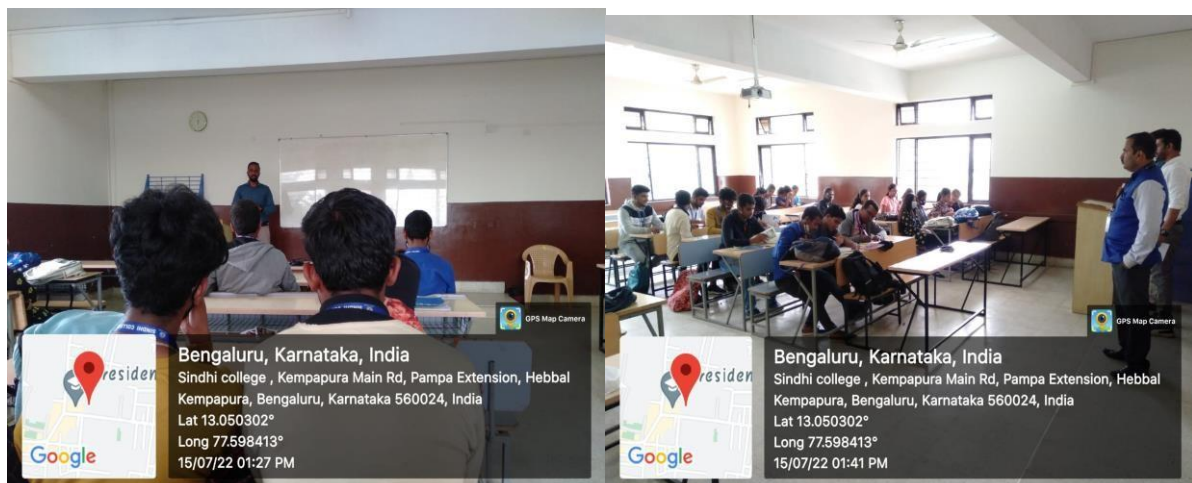
Seminar on “How to Build a Career in Entrepreneurship?”

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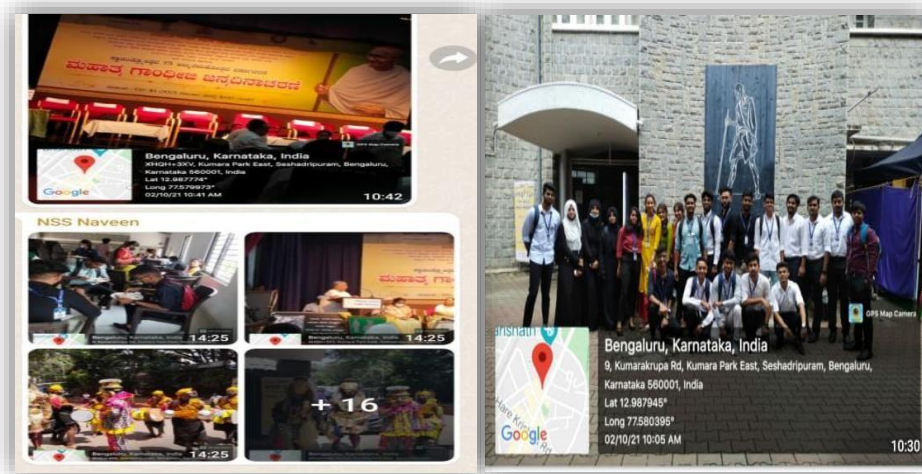

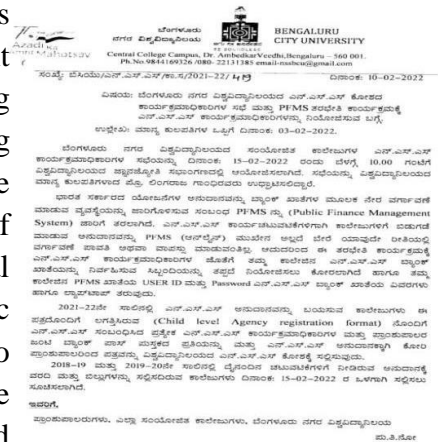
Republic Day Celebrations

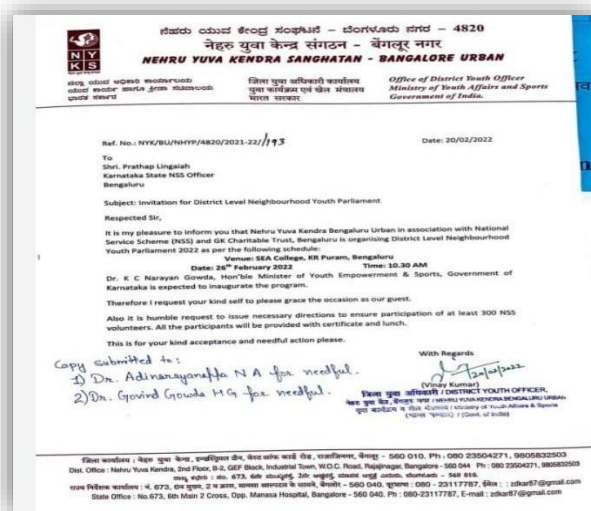
NSS Orientation Programme

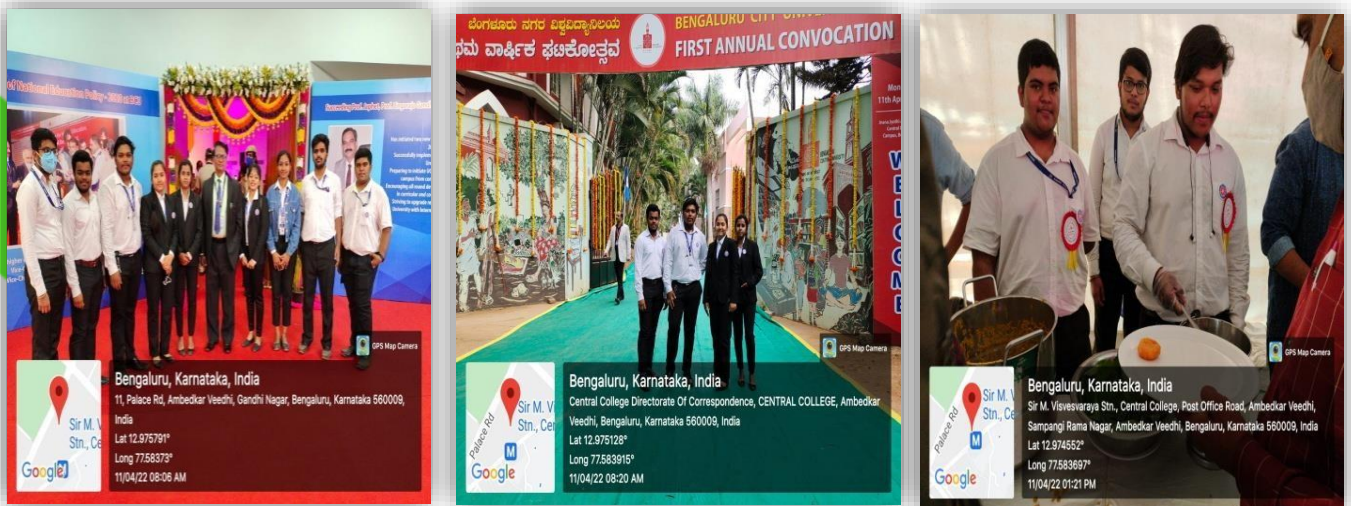


BCU Convocation Volunteering

Shramadaan

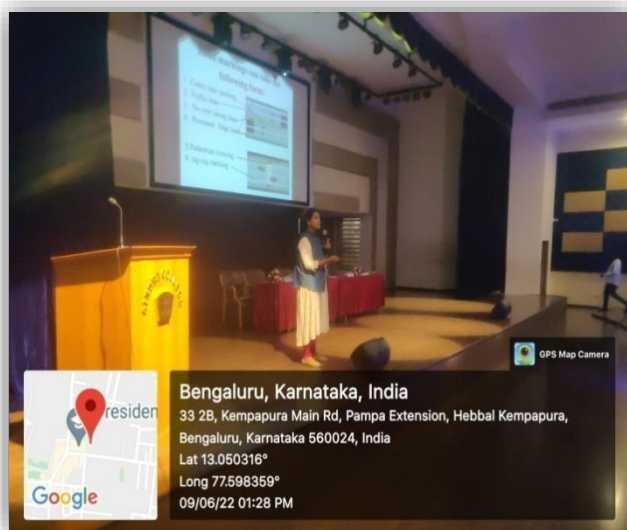

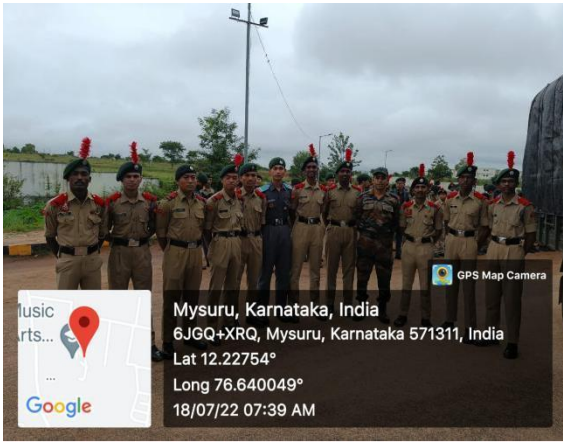
Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC)
