Centre for PG studies, organised a 7-day National level online workshop on "Writing Research Paper" from 05/04/2021 to 11/04/2021. Prof. Brijesh Singh, Associate Professor from SJB Institute of Technology, Bengaluru was the Resource Person. There were nearly 156 participants from different parts of the contry registred and 165 members attended the workshop. The first session covered topics such as, working in google drive; review of literature and structure of the Research paper.

Second day of the workshop continued with clearing of doubts that arised in the first session and covered topics such as selection of the Topic/Title of the research articles; how to write abstract; followed by, the structure of research paper for journals. The Resoruce Person explained how to frame the questionnaire and types of questions to be incorporated.

On the third day, the Resource Person scheduled a discussion on a research problem and elaborated on the "meaning of research", "business research, its advantages and types", followed by the "steps in scientific research and its process."

The object of Day 4 of the Workshop was to teach the details of sample and smapling, its types and classification. The workshop also explained about population, the steps in sampling proces, sample errors and how to calculate sample size.

On Day 5 of the workshop, the Resource Person explained about the data collection and analysis of the same in Excel, followed by the interpretation of the same.

On the Sixth day of the workshop, the Resource Person explain how to enter the data in SPSS and how to do the analysis using the SPSS. He taught statistical analysis such as descriptive, *Chi Square, T-test, F-test*, correlation and *Regression*.

On the last day of the workshop, the Resource Person cleared all the doubts of the participants. Followed by which he spoke about how to wrap up the reserach paper. He illustrated that it starts with introduction, literature review, objectives, hypothesis, analysis and suggestion. He explained how to write the references and how to publish research paper in good journals such as ugc carelist or Scopus based journals. The session was followed by collecting feedbacks from the participants. Dr. B S Srikanta, Principal of our College addressed the veledictionary speech, in which he addressed the importance of research and how reseach quality can be enhanced in our college for teachers and students. It was followed



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


