

Report of National Level Samskrita Webinar

Dr. V.B. Arathi, Director, Vibhu Academy was the Chief guest of the National Webinar organised by Department of Samskrita, Sindhi College on 29-06-21 at 11.00 a.m.

The programme was started by an invocation song by Sneha K.C of 4th Sem. B.Com followed by e-lighting of the lamp and welcome address. Welcome address was delivered by Vidwan Prof. Subrahmanya N.R. Prof. Veena Rao faculty Department of Samskrita introduced the Chief guest to the audience. Followed by Chief guest speech, Dr. V.B. Arathi started her speech, thanking the college management and principal for inviting her. From thereon it was a magical spell for 90 minutes. Each participant immersed in the intellectual and patriotic speech presented by the Chief guest. Several topics and issues were addressed during her speech.

Guest speaker pointed out that how British Rule in India dominated the will of colonised country people and methodically eliminated Samskrita and imposed English language, on the recommendations of Mac Cauley. Samskrita for ages acted as root of all languages and also as a bridge language in atleast Indian sub-continent. It served as the language to understand our culture and tradition, that was replaced by English. It is unfortunate that on alien language has become the bridge language rendering Samskrita to a 'dominate state'!

Later the speaker referred to various Saints, Rishis and Poets who have contributed towards Samskrit language enormously. During the discourse emphasis was laid on 'Prabhu Samhitha', 'Mitra Samhitha' and 'Kantha Samhitha' as three tenets of Samskrita literature. The speaker related that the works of Samskrita literature is like a Beckon to a wondering traveller in the journey of life. It shows the direction and throw light for our lives referring the "Sukha Dukhe......"

Speaker also said that Indian culture is often misunderstood by foreigners as idol worshipers. We are not just idol worshipers, we are

worshipers of ideals. Worshipping Rama people of this land are actually worshipping the virtues and ideals of Sri Rama and take inspiration to stay focused and not getting affected by worldly miseries.

Speaker also mentioned poets like Kalidasa, Bhasa, Baana, Bharavi, Magha, Vararuchi, Mayura, SriHarsha and other and their contribution to the literary world. The literary qualities found is the works of Kalidasa in Kumarasambhava would display his excellence which is evident the way he portrays the matured character of Parvathi who win the heart of lord Shiva after performing severe austerity and penance. Stotras, subhashitas, were also discussed.

It was concluded thus, apart from political interest, genuine interest from the people of the land is what is required to make Samskrit as the 'National language'. It was also opined that Samskrita like other Indian languages is not confined to regional identity. More than 50% of Dravidian languages have borrowed words from Samskrita lexicon. Finally it was agreed that, it would be apt and appropriate to present Samskrita as National language in front of the world communities.

Principal during his presidential address appreciated the scholarship of speaker and also thanked for accepting invitation and gracing the occasion. Principal reiterated the importance of safe guarding the treasure trove of knowledge hidden in palm scripts written in Samskruta language. He regretted for not getting an opportunity to study Samskrita and also wished to study at this age. His words had enough to inspire young students to respect and learn 'Samskritha' to save our 'Samskriti'.


1st International Sports Webinar

Discrete mathematics is the branch of mathematics dealing with objects that can assume only distinct, separated values. The term "Discrete Mathematics" is therefore used in contrast with "Continuous Mathematics," which is the branch of mathematics dealing with objects that can vary smoothly and which includes, for example, calculus. Whereas discrete objects can often be characterized by integers, continuous objects require real numbers. The study of how discrete objects combine with one another and the probabilities of various outcomes is known as combinatorics. Other fields of mathematics that are considered to be part of discrete mathematics include graph theory and the theory of computation. Topics in number theory such as congruence's and recurrence relations are also considered part of discrete mathematics. The study of topics in discrete mathematics usually includes the study of algorithms, their implementations, and efficiencies. Discrete mathematics is the mathematical language of computer science, and as such, its importance has increased dramatically in recent decades. The set of objects studied in discrete mathematics can be finite or infinite. The term finite mathematics is sometimes applied to parts of the field of discrete mathematics that deals with finite sets, particularly those areas relevant to business.


Then the session was opened for discussion. The participants came up with queries which were diligently answered by the speaker.

On Day 5 of the workshop, the Resource Person explained about the data collection and analysis of the same in Excel, followed by the interpretation of the same.



On 19th January, 2021, an orientation workshop was organised by Centre for PG Studies, Sindhi College in association with SkillingIndia for I year students of M. Com and M. Com (FA) on interpersonal communication skills and how to become a people expert.

Second part of the session was handled by Mr. Avishek Chatterjee. He spoke about Talent acquisition and Talent management. Explained the various stages of recruitment process. The speaker said that talent acquisition is quickly evolving into a unique and important job function. The speaker briefly explained the skills required to become an effective recruiter and talent acquisition expert.
