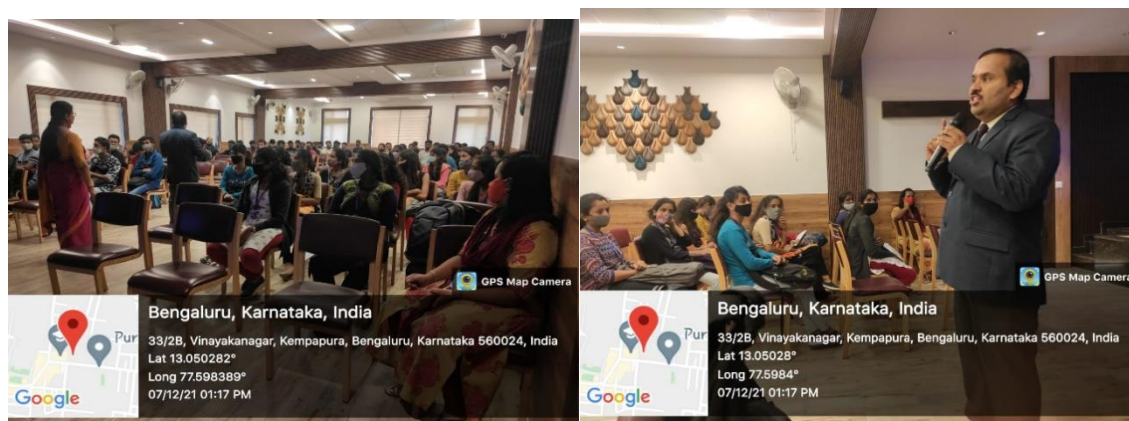


Soft Skills 2021-22



Report on CRT Classes for B.Com, B.Sc & BA

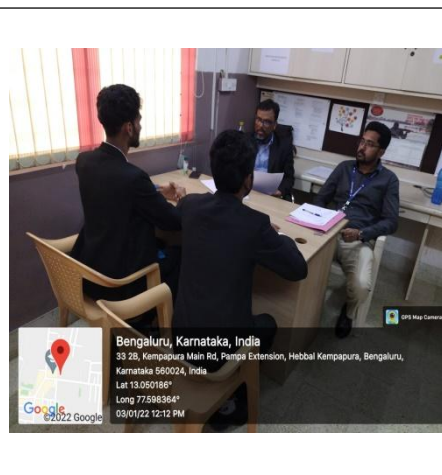
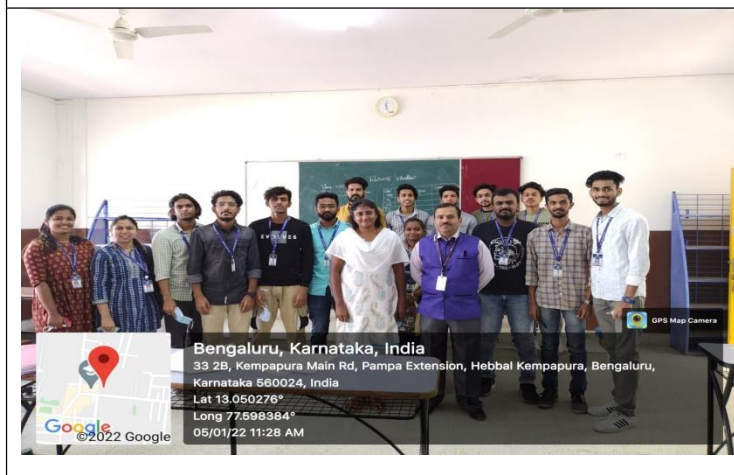

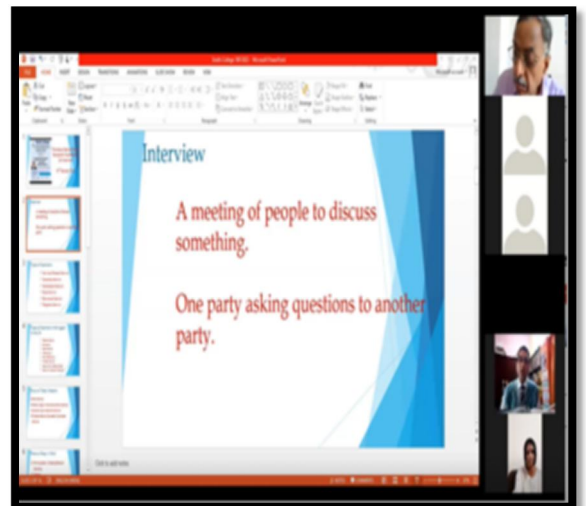


Guest Lecture on “The Secret Behind Every Successful Candidate’s Job Interview”

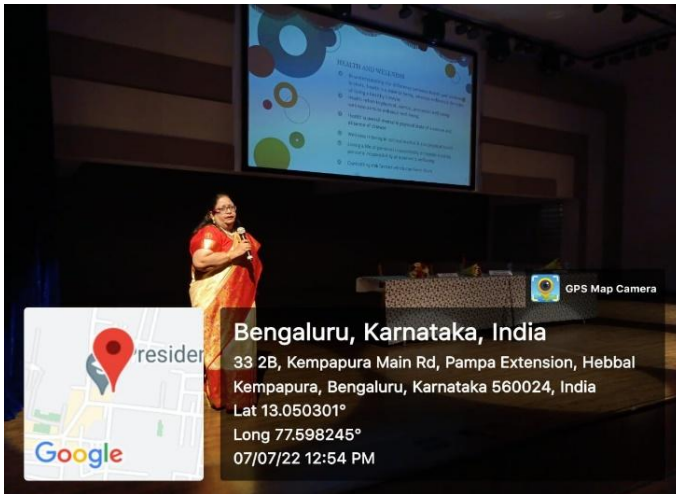
Guest Lecture on “Hindi Bhasha Rozgar Nirman me Sahayak”

Guest Lecture on “Healthy Lifestyle and Mental Health for Youngsters”



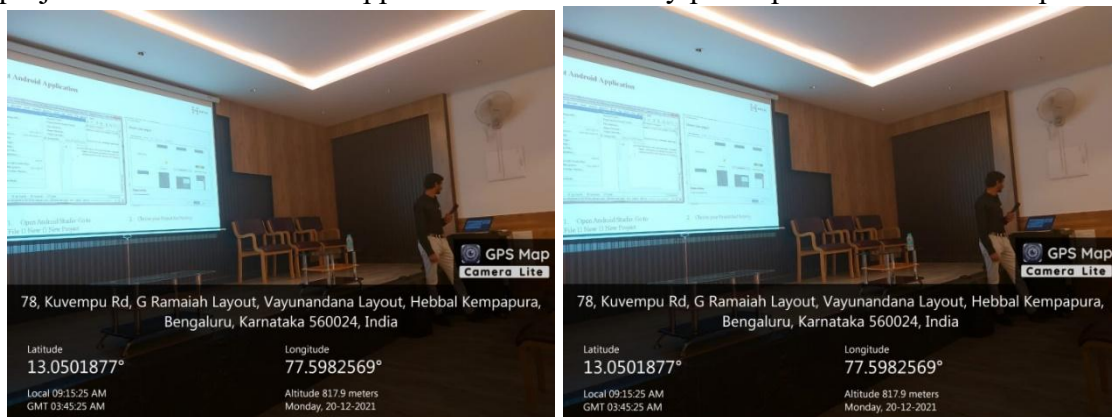

Workshop on “Android App Development”

Resource Person of the workshop was Mr.Narendra Kumar, Technology Lead – Mobile Application. He started the session with the installation of Android Studio and explained the types of the components used for App development. The students were divided into groups and given small projects to create Android App. 115 students actively participated in the workshop.



Workshop on “Introduction to SPSS”

Centre for PG Studies, organised an online workshop on Introduction to SPSS on 30.5.2022. Dr. Senthil Kumar, Assistant Professor from Scott Chritian College, Nagarcoil was the Resource Person. There were 11 participants from M.Com (FA). The workshop started with enter data in variable view and data view. The resource person described about the scaling techniques, data entry, data edit in SPSS and data transfer from excel. He practically explained how to do the data analysis. He taught statistical anaysis such as descriptive, *Chi Square*, *T-test*, *F-test*, correlation and *Regression* using SPSS.



Workshop on “Data Analysis”

On 25th August 2022, a Workshop on “Data Analysis” was organised by Centre for PG Studies, Sindhi College for M.Com, M.Com(FA) and BBA students. The resource person was Dr Madhu S, Professor, Tumkur University. A total of 55 students from 1st and 2nd year M.Com and M.Com (FA) and 60 students from II Year BBA attended the program. Dr Madhu S started the session with the basics of data analysis (Theory Part) that is what are the components in SPSS. The session was all about practical aspects of how to do data analysis in SPSS and steps to perform different tests like correlation, one way and two way anova, one sample T-Test, paired T-Test, Independent T-Test, Chi Square Test and Regression analysis. The session was very informative and enhanced the students’ knowledge on Research and Data Analysis as it is being studied in the current semester.



Two-Day Workshop on “Financial Modelling”

Two Day Workshop on Financial Modelling was organised by Centre for PG Studies, Sindhi College on 8th & 9th October 2022. Dr. Dharmendra H, Assistant Professor, Acharya Institute of Graduate Studies, Bengaluru was the resource person. 26 students of 2nd semester M.Com & M.Com(FA) and 25 outside participants attended the workshop.

The session was very informative and enhanced the participants’ knowledge of financial modelling. The students were made to develop well-structured, robust and dynamic financial models to project the future financial performance and valuation model for company valuation.

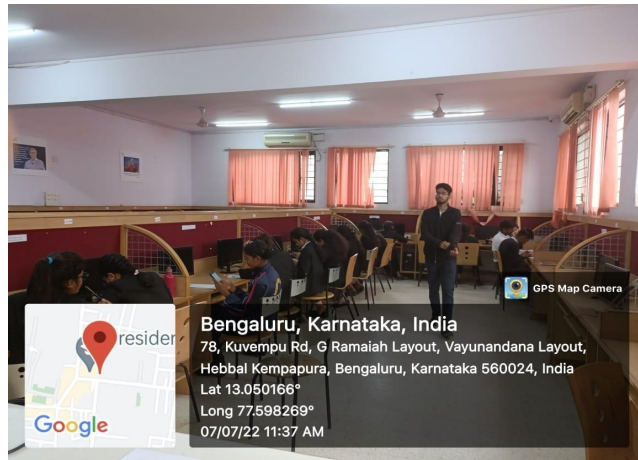


Report on IOT & Cyber Security
