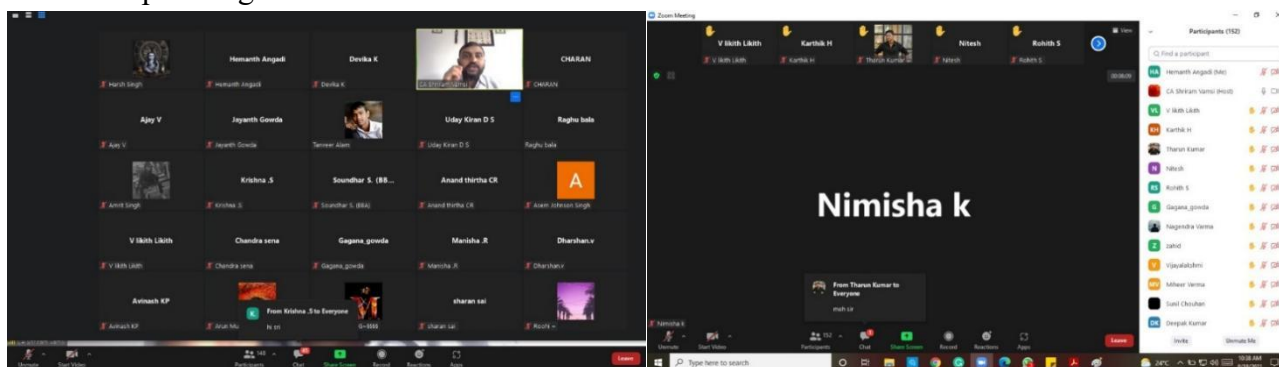


Guidance for Career Counselling

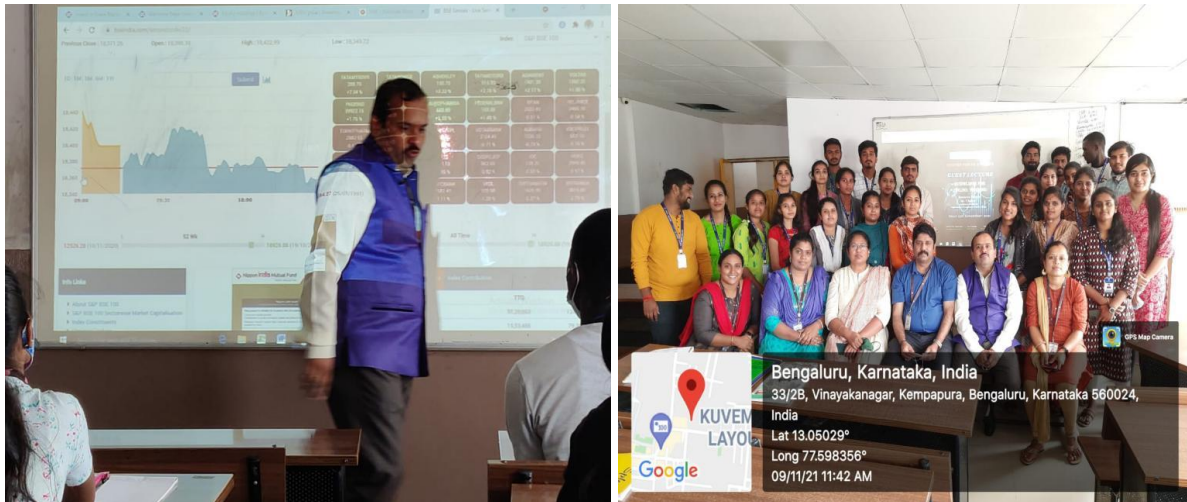
Guest Lecture on “Career Guidance”

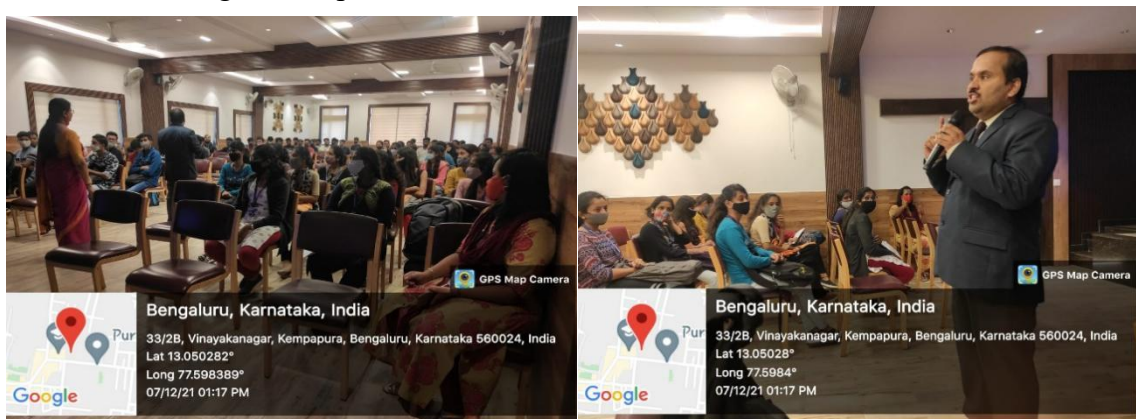
Guest Lecture on “Guidelines for Online Trading”

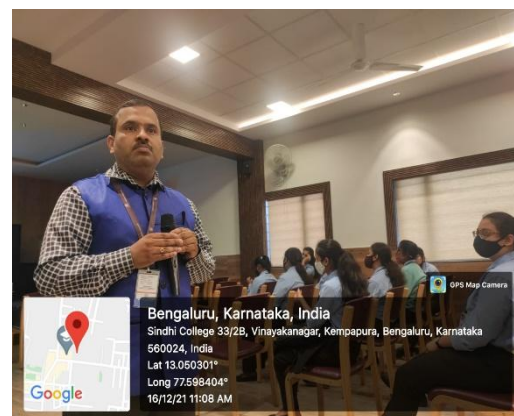
Guest Lecture on “Resume Building”

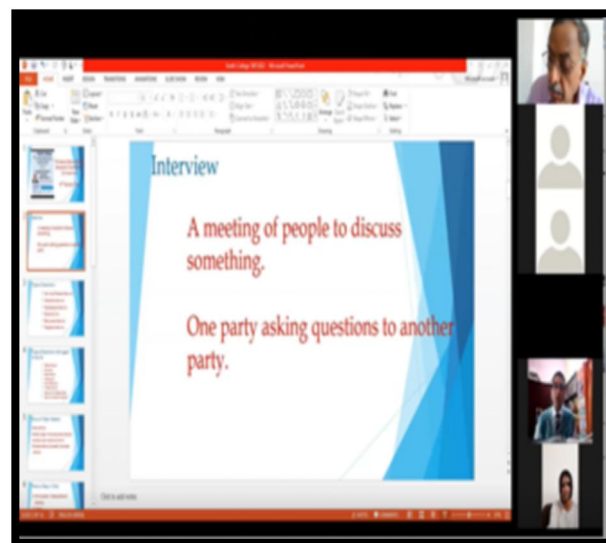
Guest Lecture on “Career Guidance”

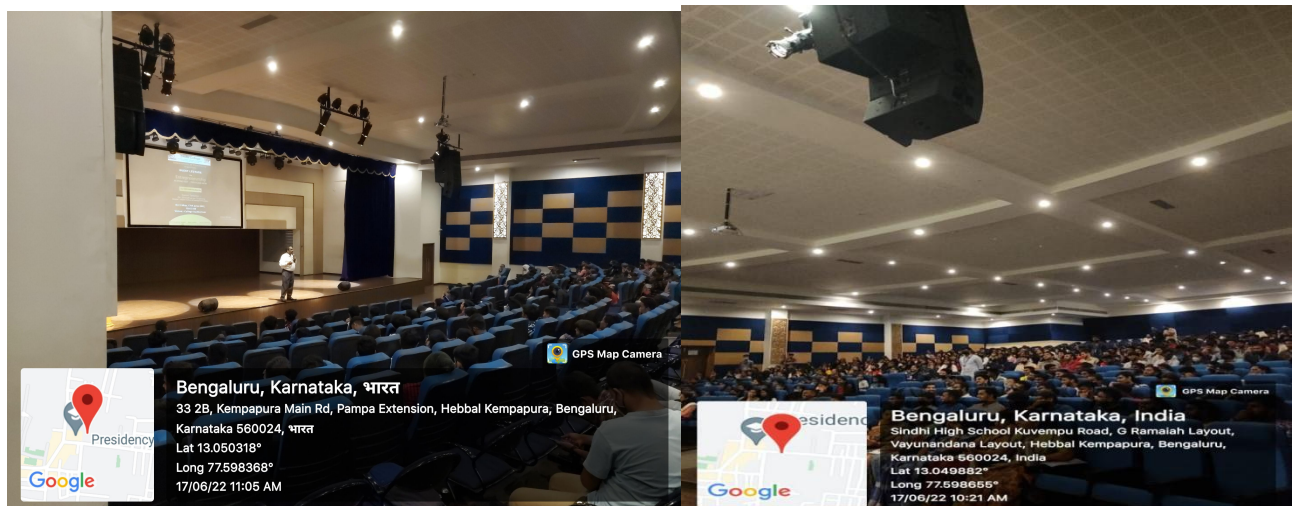
Guest Lecture on “Emerging Trends in Electronics and Career Opportunities in Research and Industry”

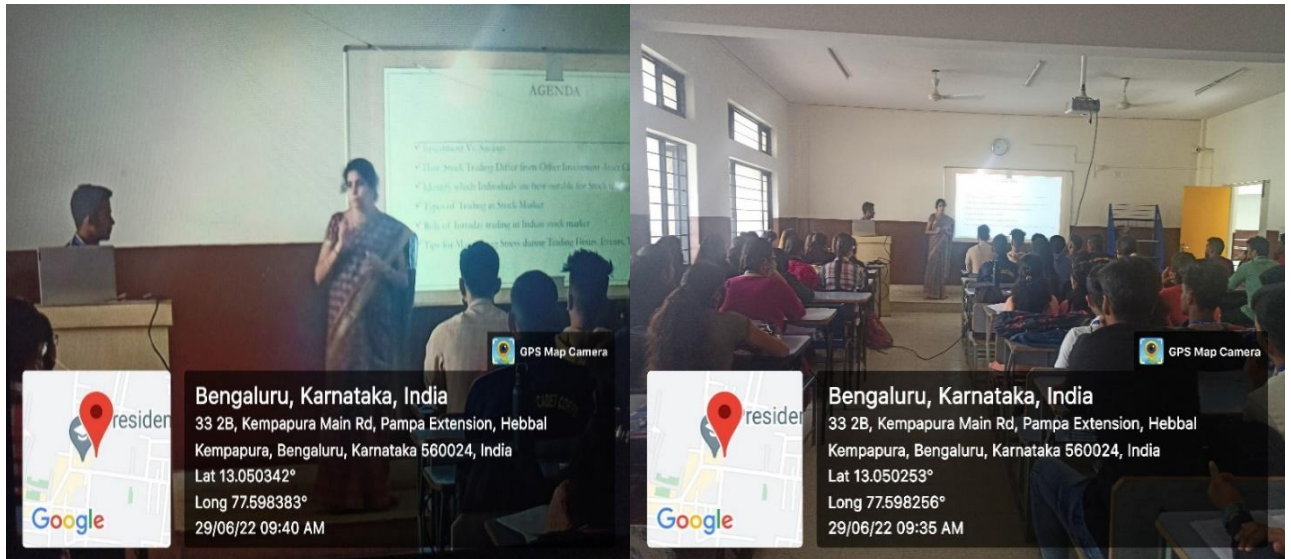
Guest Lecture on “Entrepreneurship: A Mindset - You Can Win”

Guest Lecture on “Resume Building”

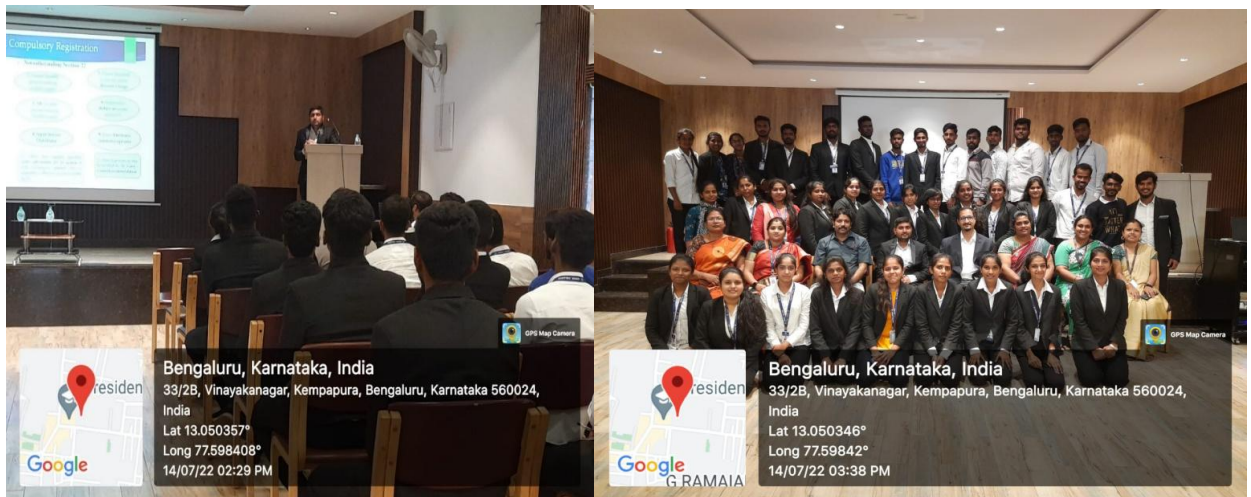

Guest Lecture on “Practical Aspect of GST”

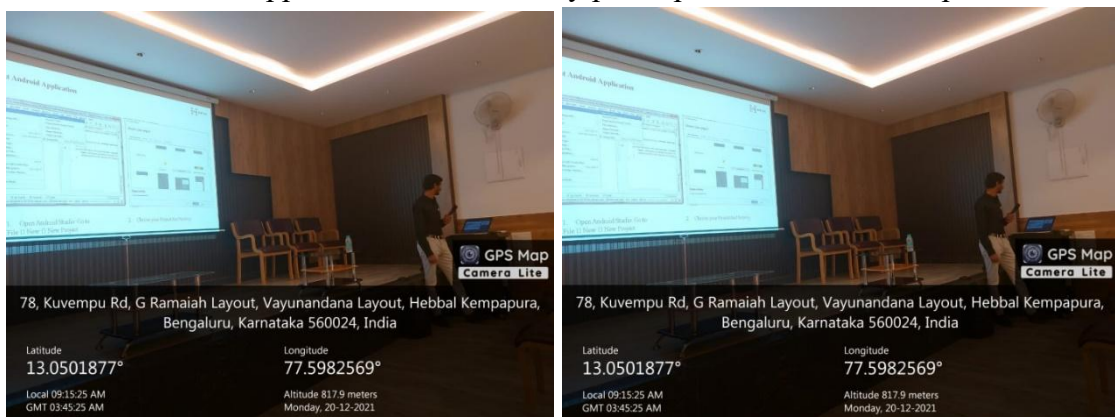

Workshop on “Android App Development”

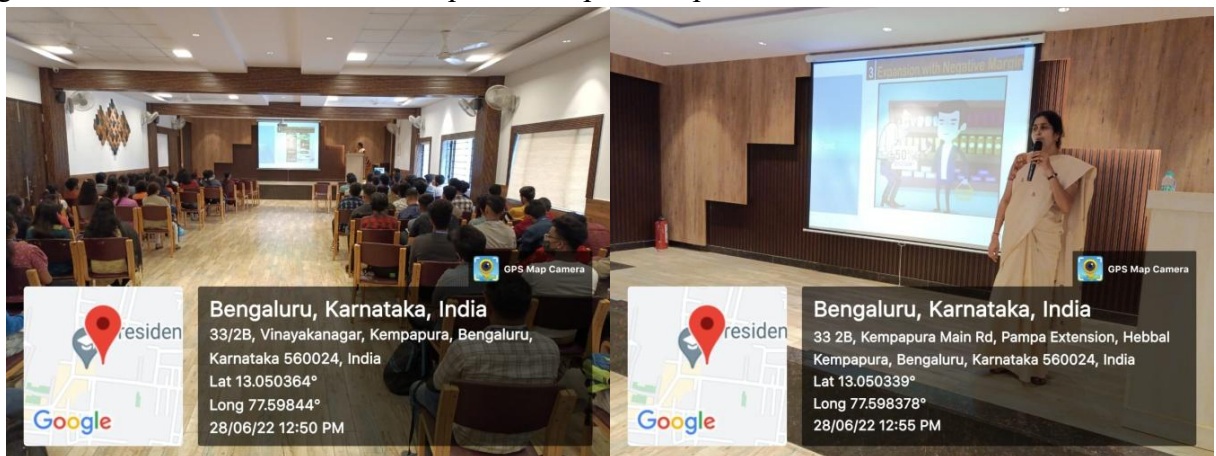
