

Report:

The talk on the topic "Neither Him, Nor Her, But Me" was organized by the department of BA. The speaker Dr. Akkai Padmashali, a recipient of Rajyothsava Prashasthi, the second highest civilian award of state government, Karanataka, and a state convenor of Na-Nayaki, social and political activist who represents the entire community of Transgenders in the state, was indeed a powerful influence on the young minds.

The speaker began by sharing her story to the students. The way she discovered her gender identity and how when she came out of the closet to the family, she was thrown out at the age of 8 to sleep in the busy streets of city market and was sexually exploited at a very young age. Going forward, her family took her back but with a condition to behave and act like a man. Although accepting the condition and staying with the family, things started to wear out during her adolescent age as she couldn't hide her identity anymore and this time more stronger, she had to rebel upto a point where she decided to end her own life. That was a turning point in her life which made her realize that she as an individual is PERFECT and not others who are expecting her to fake her identity.

Out of the realization was born a true revolutionist, who goes on to change the way the world see transgenders in the society. The speaker threw a light on the struggles that transgenders face on a daily basis. The way they are exploited sexually and otherwise. The speaker fondly remembered her late friend who had passed away on the road, and her body was lying in a public toilet, covered with maggots and nobody to hep burry the body. She expressed how officials in a very well known

hospital facility and cemetery declined to conduct postmortem or cremate the body only because her friend who had passed away was a transgender and also had no proof of identity which was declined by the government. This incident deeply hurt the very sentiments of all the transgendered community and learning this incident the speaker in the year 2016 donated her body for medical research. Soon after her introduction to her past, she challenged the entire audience with a question who are transgenders? Although the answer to this was a easy one, yet the complexity of the question invoked curiosity among all those who were present. The entire session resonated loudly that left the audience not only accepting transgenders as a part of the society but also to understand that every human being has a right to chose his or her own identity and one must be respected not because of their gender but simply because they are human being.

Soon after the talk was over, the forum was open for questions. The speaker was kind enough to address every question that was posed and also engaged in debunking many myths that were traditionally associated with transgenders. In concluding, the talk was not just an eye opener but also was very effective in making the audience understand that they are also people like any other and accepting them and sensitizing them to gender inclusivity and gender fluidity was the essence of the talk. The talk concluded with taking an oath by everyone to respect and not treat any human being with disgust and shame.




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Women Empowerment Cell and Anti Sexual Harassment Cell Guest Lecture on "Healthy Lifestyle and Mental Health for Youngsters"







Objective: To develop the sense of awareness about the Narcotic Drugs abuse and its negative nfluence on humanity.



Date: 14th June 2022




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
