Minutes of Governing Council Meeting of Sindhi College held on Tuesday, the 13th June, 2023 at 11am in the college Board Room to discuss the following agenda.

After the formal welcome, with the permission of the Chair, agenda was taken up for discussion.

3. Presentation of final semester results of University Examination-September, 2022

Presented.

Dr. Jalaja, University representative appreciated the efforts of teachers and students and advised to continue with the laudable practice of appreciating class toppers, semester toppers and centum scorers by presenting appreciation certificates and trophies on the occasion of college annual day or on any other appropriate occasion. She also said that recognizing the achievements of the students has crucial in fostering a culture of academic excellence and motivating others to strive for their best.

4. To discuss the students' feedback on curriculum for the year 2022-23

From the analysis of the students' feedback on curriculum, it is understood that the existing curriculum is inadequate to prepare students for the job market.

In light of this feedback, the Principal briefed the council that in order to bridge the gap and enhance the students' readiness for the job market, various Value Added Certificate Programs have been identified. These programs have been carefully selected based on recommendations provided by industrial experts who are well-versed with the current corporate and market trends. The introduction of these Value Added Programs supplements the existing curriculum and provide students with practical knowledge and skills that are required in the industry.

5. Presentation of reports on major events/activities conducted in the college after the previous meeting.

The Principal made a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the major activities conducted in the college since the last meeting.

Dr. Jalaja appreciated the collective dedication and hard work put forth by the Management, executives, and staff in creating an environment that nurtures the holistic development of the students.

6. To apply to the university for withdrawal of seats in BBA and M.Com courses from 140 to 120 and 50 to 40 respectively

The Principal explained to the Committee as the Management intended to limit the number of sections in BBA to two and in M.Com to one, it was resolved to apply for withdrawal of 20 seats in BBA (from 140 to 120) and 10 seats in M.Com (from 50 to 40)

7. Any other subject with the permission of the chair.

In response to Dr. Jalaja's inquiry regarding the steps taken towards the professional development of the teachers, the Management briefed the Council that they are committed to ensure continuous growth and enhancement of the faculty members and several initiatives as listed below, have been implemented to support their professional development.

- Seminars, Conferences and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs): Regular seminars, conferences, and FDPs are organized to enhance the knowledge and skills of the teachers. These events provide opportunities for professional growth, exchange of ideas, and staying updated with the latest developments in their respective fields.
- Support to participate in external Seminars/Conferences: Teachers are encouraged to attend seminars and conferences organized by other colleges and are encouraged to do paper presentations and publications. To facilitate their participation, OOD facility is provided. The registration charges and paper publication charges associated with these events are also reimbursed by the institution.
- Provision of Laptops: Laptops are provided to teachers to support their teaching activities and enable them to utilize digital resources effectively. This ensures that they have the necessary tools to deliver high-quality techno-based teaching.

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- Encouragement to pursue Ph.D and also Management sponsored Minor Research Projects: Teachers are encouraged to pursue Ph.D. degrees to enhance their knowledge in their respective disciplines. Besides, financial support is given to teachers to take up minor research projects.
- Access to Inlibnet and Research Centre: To facilitate research and other academically oriented activities, teachers are granted access to Inlibnet, an online portal. This access enables them to explore a wide range of academic resources which facilitate their research endeavours.
- Concession in Fee for Employees' Children: As a gesture of support and appreciation, employees' children are given up to 60% concession in their institutional fee within the Sindhi Group of Institutions.
- Employee Benefits: Staff members receive benefits such as gratuity, provident fund and group insurance as per the statutory obligations. These benefits contribute to their financial security and overall well-being.

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Dr. Jalaja appreciated the initiatives taken by the Management towards the professional development of the teachers and the welfare measures implemented for the staff. Dr. Jalaja acknowledged that these efforts have significantly contributed to the growth and success of the institution.

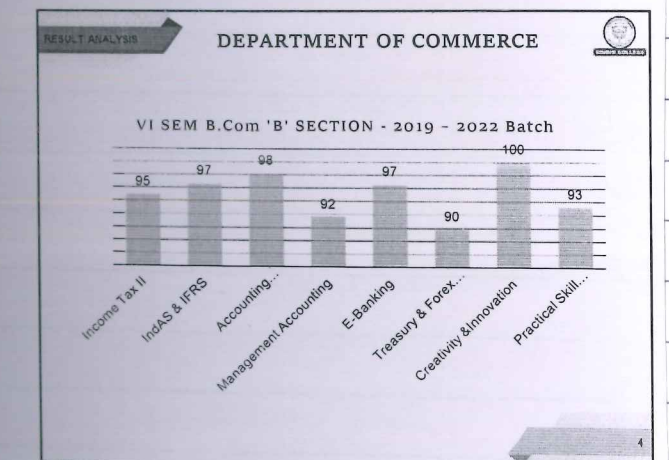
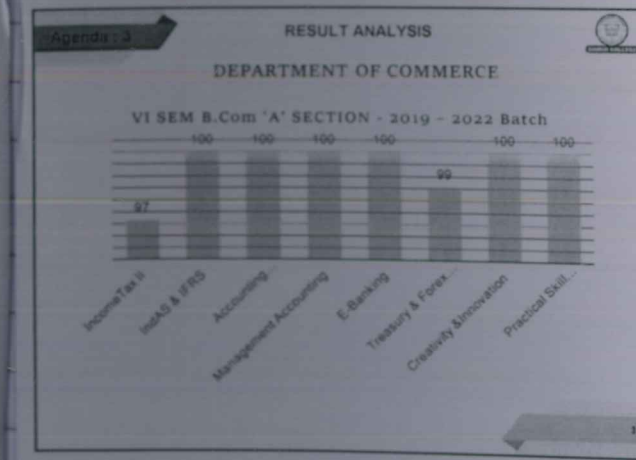
