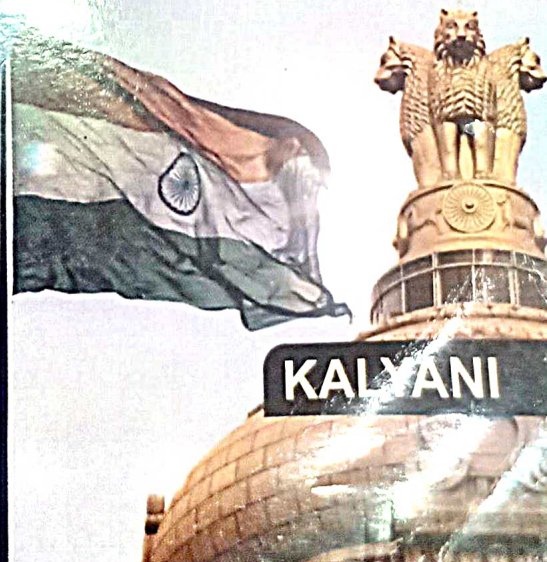

Participants: 45(25 boys 20 girls)

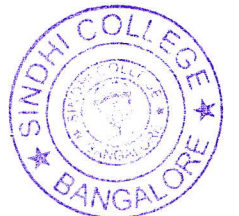
Objective:

- Gained more knowledge on MK GANDHI.





Volunteers become conscious of environment Protection.





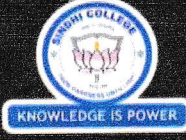

Venue:-Byatarayanapura Bengaluru

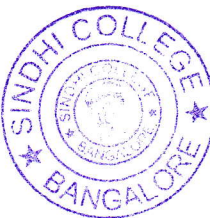
Participants:- 57 (25 boys 32 girls)

Process of election. Participants also took pledge to cast their valuable vote.

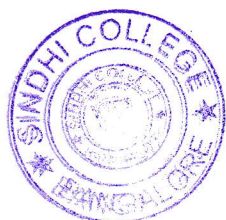


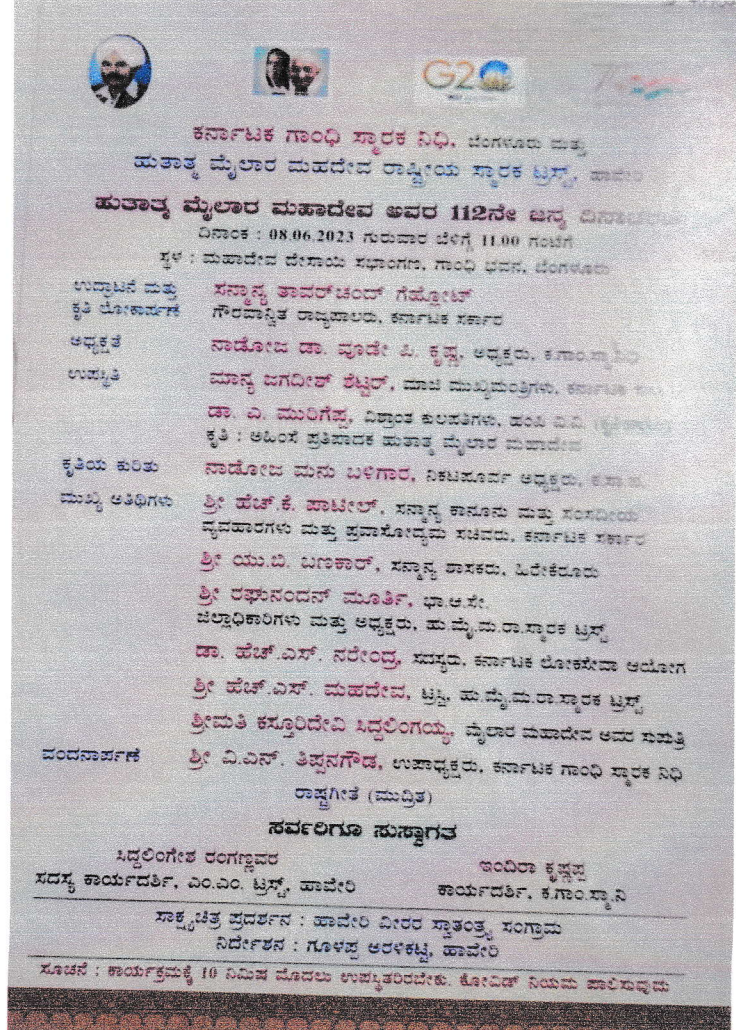
Volunteers assembled again to watch a shortfilm based on freedom fighters and their contributions for the country. The film had a lasting impact on all the participants


