To spread awareness about "Gandhian rules and Principles" to the youngsters.






impacts of climate change and human activities on water resources. This experience prompted discussions on the importance of water conservation and the need for sustainable water management practices.

To spread awareness about "Gandhian rules and Principles" to the youngsters.


