Sindhi College understands the importance of the same and has organised 8 days virtual FDP on topic very much relevant to the present trends, research titled "Quantitative data analysis using SPSS with interpretation and writing research article with Al from 14° to 21° June 2024. The program was organised in association with Primax.



DAY 1

Dr Aarthy from Christ University, Bengaluru was invited as the guest for the first day to talk on the basics of research. Dr Aarthy is a very knowledgeable in the area of research. Mam spoke on types of Variables, types of data and methods of data collection, different measurement scales used, identification of problem, hypothesis setting, population, sampling and types, statistical tools the measure the data.

DAY 2

Dr.Janani Ravinagarajan, VIT University, Chennai was invited as the guest fro day 2 to talk on SPAA. The session was very useful as it was not practical session. All participants were asked to install SPSS software which was provided by the organisers. Dr.Janani shared the data and for the same SPSS was used to analyse the data. The session also focused on testing reliability of data and validation of data collected. Day 2 was more of hand on were all participants were using the software and learning.

Day 3

Dr. Arthi from Kristu Jayanthi College chaired the session as resource person on 3* day. Mam is a eminent personality in teaching and research field. Her area of interest was on framing. Hypothesis and testing the same.

The session gave an insight on framing hypothesis as this is the most important area based on which the research work is conducted. Dr Arthi discussed on the use of On sample t-testing, independent sampling t-test, Paired t-test, Chi-square and content analysis and reliability test. This information helped the participants to understand when to use different statistical tools.

Day 4

Dr. Somsundaram from Kristu Jayanthi College, Bengaluru. 4th day focused on one way and two way Anova, Cluster analysis. These three are amongst important statistical tools used, that allows researchers to find and explore underlying themes in order to explain similarities or dissimilarities between investigated datasets.

Day 5

Dr. Sathish from Christ University Bengaluru chaired as the resource person fro 5the day. Topic for the day was on correlation and regression. This is also a statistical tool used in analysis the data. The session used data, which was a practical session. All participants participated by using the data and learning about the statistical tool.

Day 6

Dr.Arthi from Kristu Jayanti College, Bengaluru chaired 6the day as resource person on the topic Mediation and Moderation based regression analysis. This is a tool used in clinical research to study how it operates and when it exists. The speaker briefed the uses of the tool, on the data that can be used on these tools.

Day 7

Dr.Sathish P., Christ University, Bengaluru was the resource person on the topic Research article and selection of journals. The speaker gave an indepth knowledge on how to write an article. Publishing the article is also a vital task. Selection of journals is something which can add weightage to the article. The session elaborated on identifying the journals which are indexed on scopus, web of science and ADBC.

Day 8

Dr. Sowmiya Ranl, Editor, Editage Founder, Sowmis-AWW Coimbatore was the speaker for the last day of FDP on the topic - Al based tools for Research Writing. As Al usage is booming in all sectors, the same is used in writing research article. The session focused on Al and research writing, validating data, questions, searching literature review, image creation which can be used in the articles, simplifying data analysis using Al.



Overall 8 days sessions were collectively a very useful program for all research scholars and to all faculties in writing a good article. There was good participation with 138 participants from different institution.






