Report on Industrial visit to Mapro Industries and Katraj Diaries, Pune



A Report on Industrial Visit to Mother Dairy, Yelahanka, Bangalore on 23rd October 2019

The Department of Management had organized an industrial visit to Mother Dairy, Yelahanka, Bangalore on 23rd October 2019.Mr.Vaidyesh, Dept Head, Ms.Nandini and Mr.Srinidhi, faculty members of the Department accompanied **72 students of I** sem BBA.

The visit started at 3.30pm after the identity and security check.Mr Narendra, Marketing and Public Relations Officer co ordinated with us to guide through the plant visit. He started giving a brief introduction with chilled buttermilk offered to all of us. Mother Dairy, Bangalore, a flagship dairy of KMF having ISO22000:2005 Certification was set up during the year 1984, primarily for dispensing liquid milk to customers through Bulk Vending system. Today, the Dairy stands expanded from 2 Lakh Litres to 7 Lakh Litres milk processing per day. Also, it has facilitates to pack and distribute milk & curd in different packs formats in the most hygienic way. Besides, it has a state of the art facility to manufacture Skim Milk Powder, Dairy Whitener, as well as Whole Milk Powder to the tune of 30 MTs per day. It has established a facility to manufacture more than 30 varieties of Ice cream including pro-biotic, sugar free in the various pack formats to the tune of 15000 Litres per day. Presently, it is undertaking manufacturing and co-packing of 'Amul' brand of ice cream for GCMMF.

The visit started with the production department where the students were exposed to the milk processing and packing, milk powder processing for making sweets, ice cream making, paneer making, UHD section, finished goods section etc.

Mr Narendra also showed and explained to the students the waste and effluent processing also systematically carried out inside the plant. The visit came to end with a yummy ice cream during the question and answer session and a group photograph.

Overall, the visit gave comprehensive information about the dairy products with the practical exposure to the various processes where the students gained insights to the various concepts learnt in Production and Operations Management and Management Process in their curriculum.


He further explained about the various safety measures to be taken in the workplace to maintain the quality of the cookies. The presentation session ended after students clarifying their doubts.

The faculty and students were asked to wear a cap, remove watches, bangles, spectacles to ensure hygiene inside the workplace.


We were further guided to enter the actual process area where we witnessed how the ingredients are mixed, preparation of the cookies base, baking, packing, labelling etc.
