Rabindranath Tagore team was in-charge of cooking, cleaning and serving food. Volunteers took pride in rendering service to the community under scorching sun.


Villagers served tender coconuts to beat the heat. Lunch was served at 3:00p.m and took most needed rest till 4:00pm.

cyber-crimes, effects of demonetization and cautioned people to protect their interests.


SI Mahadevaswamy also concurred with the views expressed by CI Ramesh.

The United Nations(UN) Conference on Environment and Development - 1992, recommended that a day be celebrated to bring water literacy amidst people, and called for celebration of World Water Day. Accordingly, the UN General Assembly declared 22nd March as World Water Day, and this was celebrated for the first time in the year 1993. The main objective of world water day is to create awareness and educate the common people about the proper use of water. This year's theme for world water day is "Why Wastewater?"

In our daily life, when we use water, a significant portion of it is wasted. Many a time, more water goes down the drain than being utilized. In this regard, each one of us can do something, and that is

why this handbill is in your hands.

When you brush your teeth or shave your face, though not necessary, the tap will be on. In the real sense, you are not making use of water. Simply you are sending water down the drain. In the same manner, when vegetables are washed or vessels are washed more water is wasted than that is really used. If vegetable are rinsed for a while, and then washed, and the remaining water is used to water the plants, you can put the same water to multiple uses.

When you draw rangoli, many people wash the entire your front yard with lots of water. There is no urpose served by wasting water like this. The same thing can be achieved with little amount of water. In he hot summer days also, there is no dearth of people who wash their bike or car with lots of water. The same thing could be done using a pressure wash. What is required is some concern and discretion

when you want to use water.

It is not necessary to bathe the plant with water when you water the plants in your garden. Water for a plant is needed for the roots. A small quantity of water will do for this purpose. It would be ideal to water our garden during morning or evenings. During summer afternoon watering a plant, most of the water

will get evaporated.

It is better to use a shower to bath. While loading a washing machine, let it be loaded to full capacity. This will save water. While using a toilet to flush, it is not necessary to empty the complete flush tank. The above said are some of the small changes which everyone can try and implement to save water. That apart, ensure leaking taps and water tanks are attended for repair immediately. Even if you have the luxury of a borewell in your house, underground water will not last forever. Incase, if you have space for rainwater harvesting, this is the best time, as you can test your rain water harvesting plant during the

### REPORT ON RAIN WATER HARVESTING

The Eco Club of Sindhi College of commerce conducted a lecture on Rain water harvesting on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March, 2016. The lecture was delivered by Mr. A.R. Shivkumar who highlighted the plight of people suffering due to lack of water through videos and pictures. He also demonstrated how the concept of using rain water productively is not so widespread and why it is important for people to know about its advantages.

In his lecture he explained that rain water is the purest form of drinking water and it is not being used to its best. Currently all the rain water just flows and gets mixed with contaminants and becomes unfit for regular use. This condition can be improved by building minimum infrastructure to facilitate replenishment of underground water. He made us aware that optimal underground water levels avoid conditions like drought.

He described the different types of rain water harvesting and explained each one in detail. He made the session very educative and interactive. Students were bought into the concept and enthusiastically acknowledged the necessity and the benefits of rain water harvesting.

Our students were privileged to have listened to this lecture from Mr A R Shivkumar. He is a scientist at IISC Bangalore and the Principal Investigator for Rain water harvesting. His contribution in this area has been rightly recognised by the State and Central government and he has received prestigious awards from them. It was indeed a pleasure for us to have been a part of this lecture.
